

NEWSLETTER ARTICLE

On April 25 I had the opportunity to attend the Sewer Study Committee meeting at the Township Hall. There were ten others in attendance. Included were Larry Bamm - Township Supervisor, Geoff Snyder – County Drain Commissioner, Chuck Olson – Design Engineer from OMM Engineering, and Randy Troman (PLHA Board member) Mr. Olson stated he was looking at all types of systems based on their efficiency and cost effectiveness. There was a lot of discussion on what areas to include in the sewer district. The committee directed Mr. Olson to include Pleasant Lake, Pleasant Bay Estates, Bateese Lake, Mud Lake, White Lake, and the Crane Hollow Subdivision just South of White Lake. The trunk line would be run West along Berry road to Cooper road then South to Zion road and West to Lansing Ave. and thru Blackman township to the City of Jackson sewage treatment plant. Any additional hookups along the trunk line would lower the overall cost due to it being spread over a greater number of units. Property owners along the trunk line route could hook up to the sewer system. The main line would be a 10 – 12 “diameter line. Estimated cost figures will be discussed at the next PLHA meeting.

The next PLHA meeting will be on May 20 at 6:30PM at Hankerd Hills Golf Course. The Study Committee and the Engineer will be there to discuss their findings/recommendations.
